NO MONEY CHANGES HANDS. ARTISTS SUBMIT THEIR WORK FOR FREE, I COMPILE IT FOR FREE, AND IT WILL ALWAYS BE AVAILABLE TO EVERYONE FOR FREE. NO PAYWALL. NO ADS. EVERYTHING ABOUT THE BLIGHT COLLECTIVE COMES FROM A PLACE OF PURE LOVE FOR CREATING.

THIS WHOLE CONCEPT STARTED AS KIND OF AN HOMAGE. BACK WHEN I WAS A TEENAGER AND FIRST FINDING MY FOOTING AS A GRAPHIC DESIGNER, I STUMBLED ACROSS **BEAST MAGAZINE** BY **THOMAS SCHOSTOK**. THAT MAGAZINE IS LARGELY RESPONSIBLE FOR FIRST IGNITING MY PASSION FOR ART AND DESIGN. FOR ANYONE WHO DOESN'T KNOW IT, IT WAS A FREE PDF THAT PROVED SOMETHING I HADN'T UNDERSTOOD YET: ART DOESN'T HAVE TO BE NICE AND NEAT AND FIT INTO A BOX. IT ALSO DOESN'T NEED A GATEKEEPER, OR PERMISSION TO REACH AN AUDIENCE. IT JUST NEEDS SOMEONE WILLING TO GATHER IT AND PUT IT OUT INTO THE WORLD.

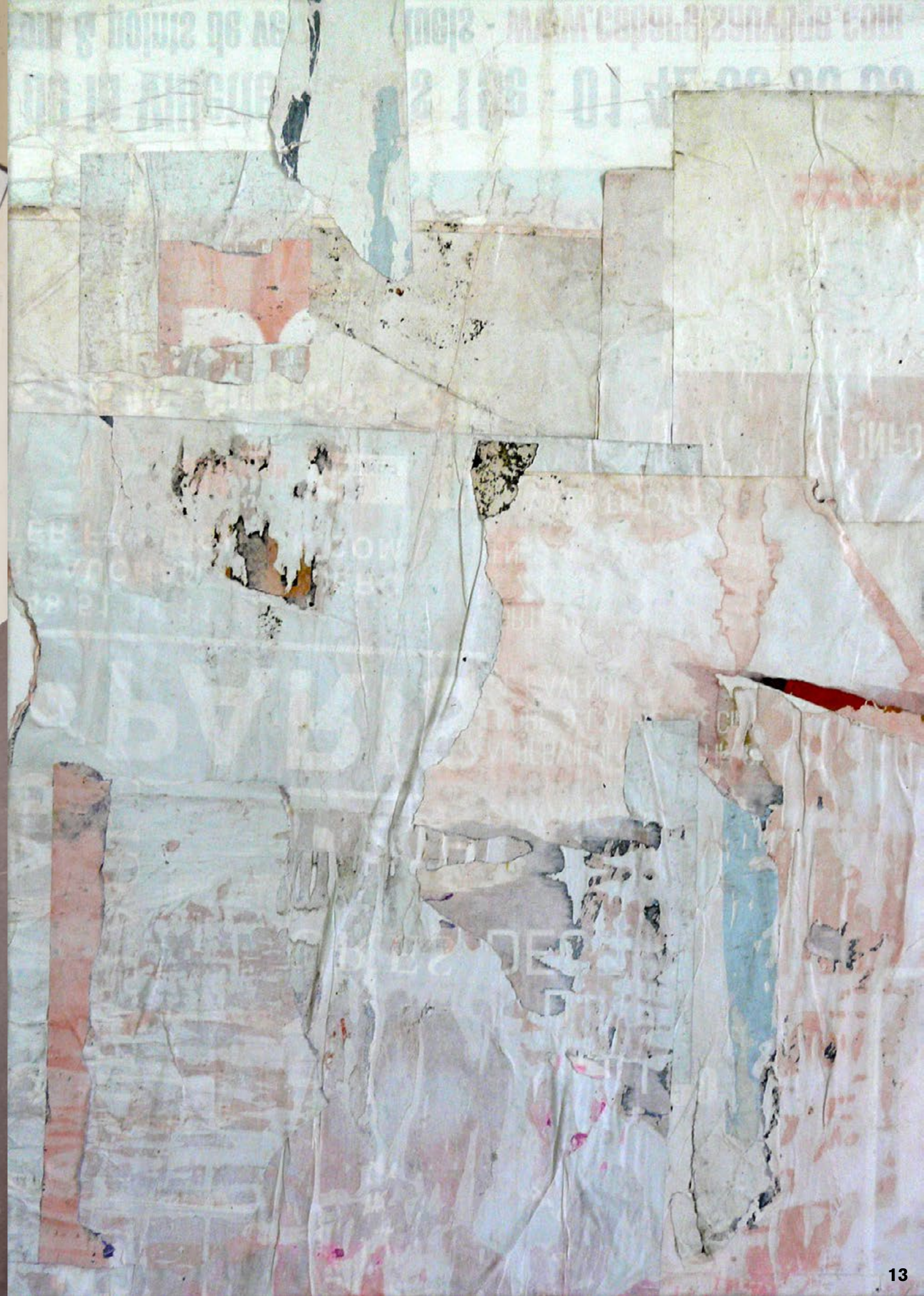

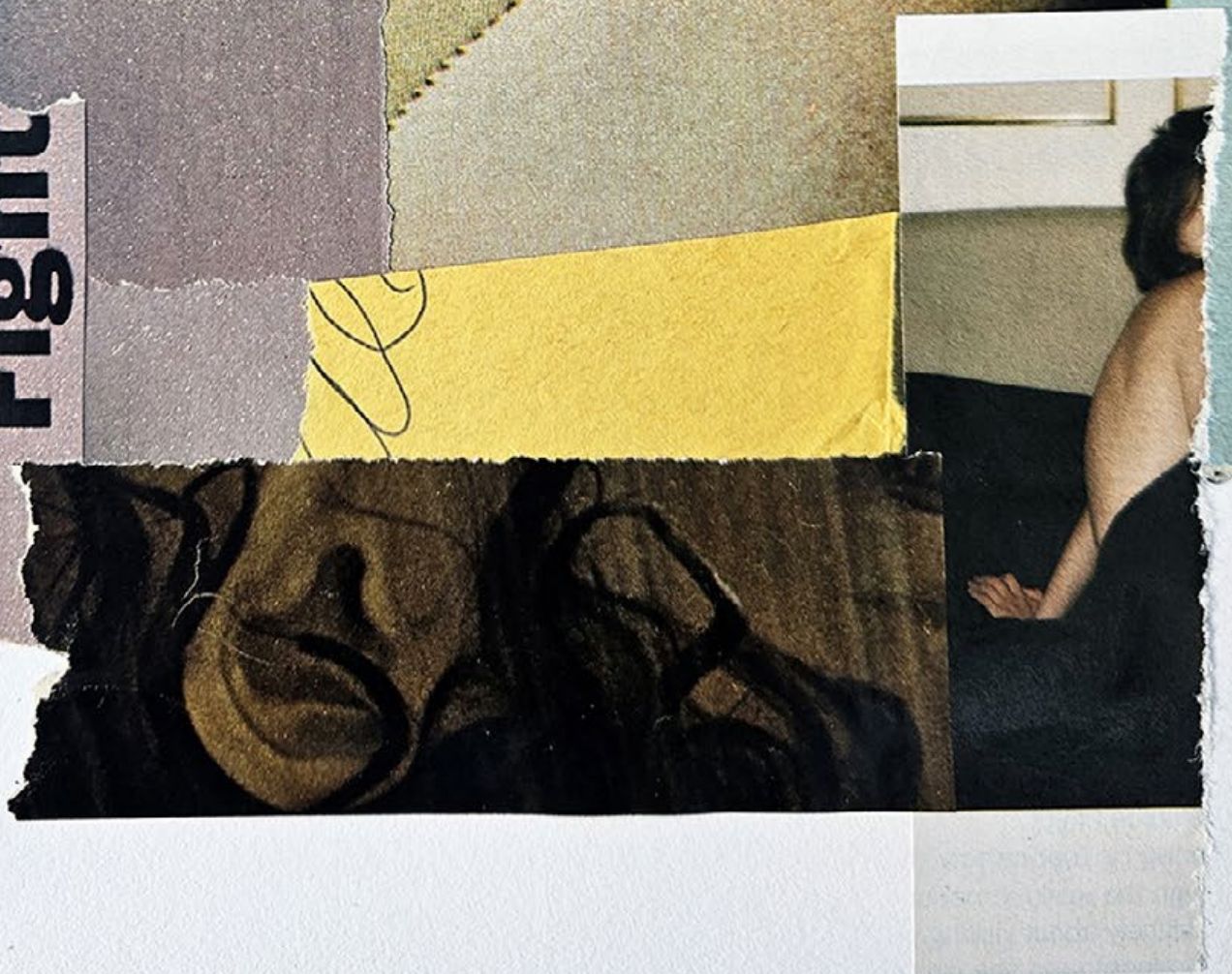

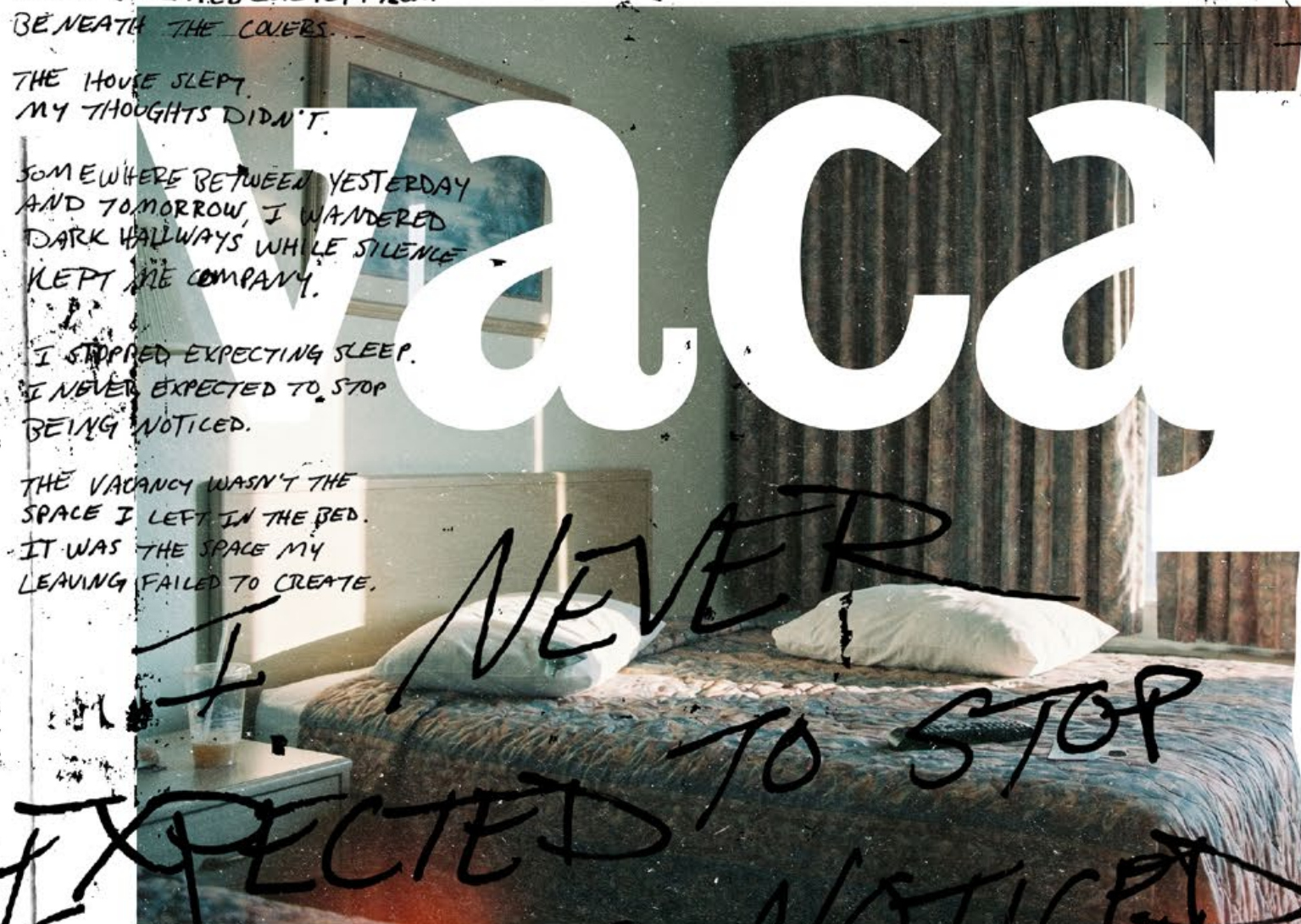

LEAVING FAILED TO CREATE.

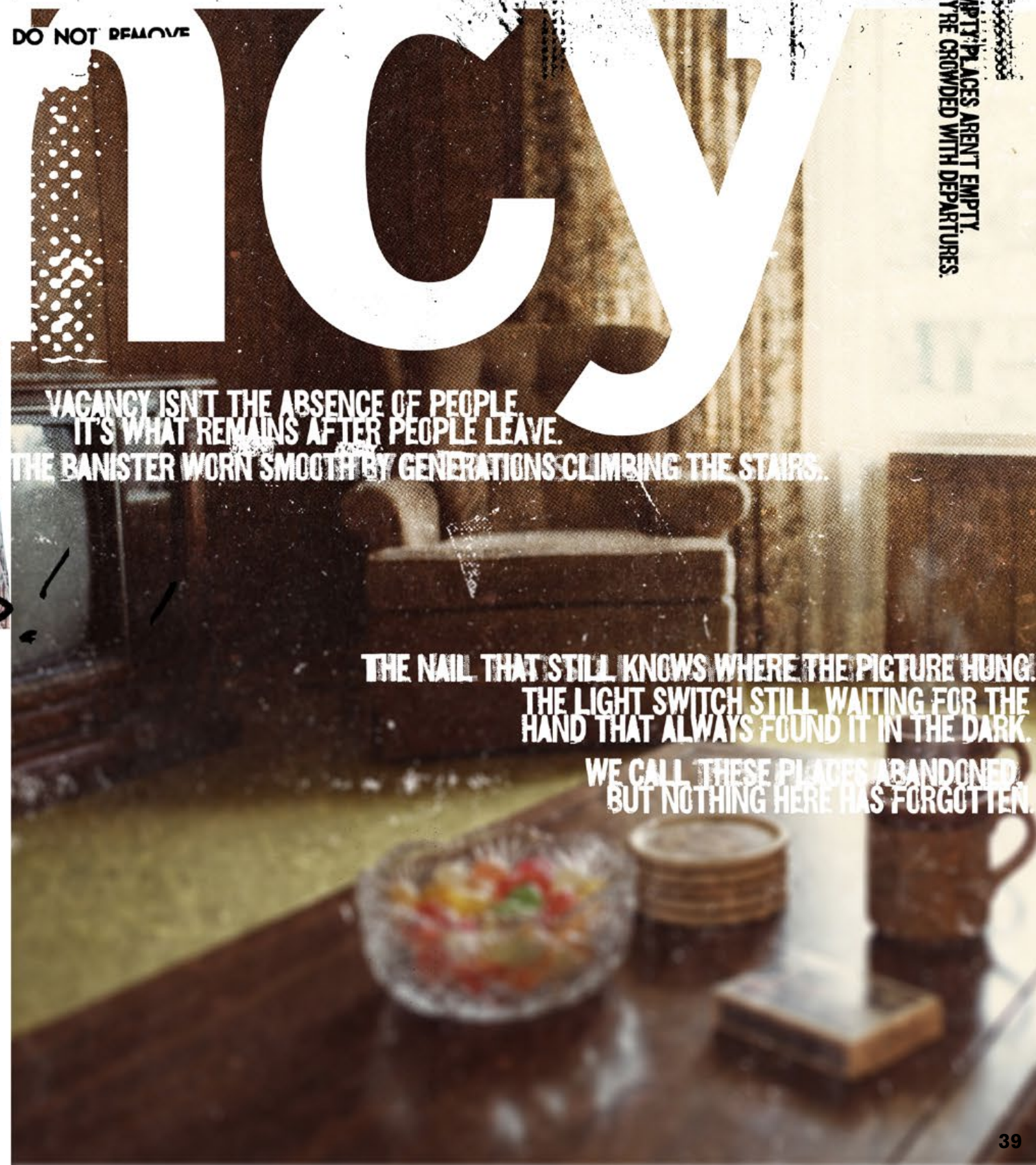
